Patrick Scholarship Fact Sheet

Background: The Grace E. and Daniel W. Patrick Scholarship fund was established by the Patrick Estate to be used specifically for use towards scholarships for those who have been patients of Shriners Children's Spokane. The Patrick Scholarship fund is managed and administered by the El Katif Shrine Board of Directors. Applicants must be at least a senior in high school and enrolling in college, technical school or a vocational school. Applicants can be part time or full-time students. These scholarships are awarded annually.

Mission Statement: El Katif Shrine provides Patrick Scholarships to qualified applicants to promote principles of service to others, community involvement and civic pursuits thru the education of young people who have high ideals and integrity.

1. The application period is open from January 1st thru March 31st of each year. Applications must be sent via USPS to:

- 2. Applications postmarked prior to January 1st of each year will be rejected.
- 3. Applications postmarked after April 1st will be rejected.

- 5. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Hand written applications will be rejected.
- 6. The application form must be accompanied by: One letter of recommendation from a Guidance Counselor or Teacher and your most recent official transcripts.
- 7. Once your application has been received, your patient status at Shriners Children's Spokane will be verified.
- 8. All applications are evaluated by a committee of Shriners and Community members selected by the Chairman of the Board, El Katif Shrine.
- 9. Scholarship award notifications will be sent no later than May 15th.
