

When you arrive...

Everyone visiting the prison has their finger print scanned and a photograph taken

Put your belongings in a locker

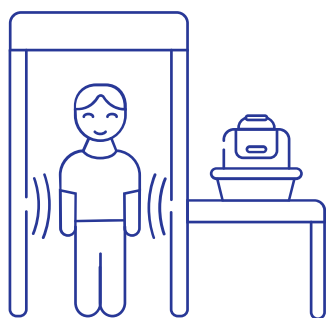


You will put your belongings into a locker - the only things you can take with you for your visit are cash to buy refreshments (max £30), your photographic ID, your locker key and your jumper/jacket if it is a cold day

Remember that you can't take any food, drinks or other items with you for your visit

Locker keys are available for a £5 refundable deposit

Searching visitors



To help keep all visitors, prisoners and staff safe, everyone who comes into the prison needs to be searched.

Any items you are taking into the visits hall - cash for refreshments, locker key, jacket/jumper - will go through an x-ray machine.

You will then walk through airport-style security.

You will also be asked to comply with a 'Level B rub down search' - this is to make sure that you are not carrying anything that is prohibited.

Please note, if you refuse to be searched you will not be allowed to enter the prison and your visit will be cancelled.

Going to the visits hall



When it is time for your visit, a member of staff will collect you from the waiting area and escort you to the visits hall - please make sure you are ready on time or you may miss your visit
