

New ways to move on Anzac Day



Getting to the Shrine of Remembrance Dawn Service, 5.30am – 6.30am

Train to Anzac Station via Metro Tunnel

Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury Line
– stay on board

Frankston Line
– change at Caulfield Station

Werribee, Laverton and Williamstown Line
– change at Footscray Station

Other lines – change at Flinders Street
to Town Hall Station

Extra tram services

Shuttle tram services run between **Stop 13 Flinders Street Station** and **Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance** from 5am.

Extra trams will also run from the suburbs into the city on most tram routes.

Accessibility Support

Travellers Aid minibus service will run from **Anzac Station Exit 4** on Domain Road to the Shrine of Remembrance via Birdwood Avenue. The minibus is not accessible for patrons requiring low floor access.

From **Stop 19 Shrine of Remembrance**, Travellers Aid volunteers offer power-assisted wheelchair support to and from the Shrine, and to parking and buses on Birdwood Avenue.

You can also hire mobility equipment, like wheelchairs or scooters, through Travellers Aid. Visit their website or call **9654 2600** to arrange this in advance.

Commemorative March, 9am – 12pm

To join the Commemorative March or head back to the city, take a train from Anzac Station or a free return bus running between the Shrine and Russell Street from 8am to 2pm.

There are changes to tram services across the network from 5.45am to 1.45pm due to road closures for the Commemorative March.
