- Fare Zones:** Indicated by dashed lines. Zone 1 covers the central Melbourne area, while Zone 2 extends further out.
- Special Event Line:** A grey line connecting the Melbourne Airport to the city center.
- Geographical Features:** Port Phillip Bay is shown to the south of Melbourne.

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
