How to apply for a new Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation/ Renewal of Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation

To be able to drive an accident tow truck, you must be accredited.

To be accredited, you must apply to the Department of Transport and Planning. The Department of Transport and Planning will assess your application in accordance with the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007* and *Accident Towing Services Regulations 2019*.

The Department of Transport and Planning has 30 days to assess your application. If additional information is required, this period may be extended. The Department of Transport and Planning will advise you in writing if this is the case.

To apply for accreditation or to renew your accreditation, you must submit the following documents to the Department of Transport and Planning in support of your application.

Application Form

Complete and sign the Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation Form, making sure to tick for 'New Accreditation' or 'Renewal of Accreditation'. Please complete every question on the form thoroughly. This will help the Department of Transport and Planning to assess your application and process it more quickly.

Passport Photos and Proof of Identification

To enable the Department of Transport and Planning to process your application, two passport-sized photographs of you, and a copy of your driver's licence are required.

The passport-sized photographs must be:

- no more than six months old and with a date by the photographer; and
- on a plain, light coloured background; and
- · an acceptable likeness to you; and
- a full front view of your head and shoulders, without any head covering or tinted glasses.
 If you normally wear prescription glasses, you should wear them for your photograph.

The Department of Transport and Planning will only accept a photograph that shows all your facial features.

Application for Denouval of Approxitat

A copy of your driver's licence is required as proof of identification.

Application for New Accorditation

Submit application

A non refundable application fee is payable to the Department of Transport and Planning. This fee is for processing your application. If you are successful you will be issued with an Accident Tow Truck accreditation certificate for up to three years. You need to download this form and fill in the correct sections. The form will need to be uploaded to transport. vic.gov.au and submit your form, along with the supporting documentation to support your exemption application. You will have to pay a fee when you submit your documents. Once the application is submitted, you will receive a confirmation email from the Department of Transport and Planning.

National Police Certificate

A current National Police Certificate issued within the last six months is required. You can go to the Victoria Police website police.vic.gov.au to order the National Police Certificate, or you can use an online provider, who has been accredited by the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC). Certificates may take up to ten working days and the original certificate must be sent to the Department of Transport and Planning with your application.

Privacy Statement

The Department of Transport and Planning is committed to protecting your privacy by fully meeting its responsibilities under the *Road Safety Act 1986, Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014* and the *Health Records Act 2001*. All personal information you provide will be handled in accordance with these requirements. The collection of information on this form is required by the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*. Information held by the Department of Transport and Planning may be disclosed to various organisations, including the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal and Victoria Police, in order to carry out their duties under the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*.
