## Applying for a General Identification Mark (GIM)/Trade plate

An individual or company that is:

- a manufacturer of vehicles; or
- a dealer in vehicles; or
- a fleet owner (owns more than 50 vehicles); or
- a licensed vehicle tester; or
- a person or body of persons providing a service of inspecting and checking vehicles for mechanical condition and efficiency; or
- a person engaged in the business of altering, modifying, repairing or transporting vehicles before registration

may apply for a General Identification Mark (GIM) to be assigned to them and be issued one or more trade plates on payment of the applicable fees.

### How do I apply for a GIM/Trade plate?

If you meet the eligibility requirements below, complete the application form, provide the required evidence and pay the appropriate fees.

Documents and fees should be lodged at any VicRoads Customer Service Centre or sent to: VicRoads, GPO Box 1644, Melbourne Vic 3001

### Trade plate fees

The relevant fee for the GIM, each trade plate and the applicable Transport Accident Commission (TAC) charge for the type of vehicle/risk zone is payable.

## GIM/Trade plate eligibility requirements

### A manufacturer of, or a dealer in, vehicles/trailers

The above eligible person or a person acting on their behalf may use the vehicle on a highway with a trade plate attached to the rear of the vehicle to:

- drive the vehicle in the process of manufacture from place to place; or
- drive the vehicle from the place of manufacture to the place where the vehicle will be offered for sale; or
- test drive the vehicle; or
- drive the vehicle to demonstrate its powers and qualities to a purchaser or prospective purchaser; or
- drive the vehicle in the course of its delivery before or after sale; or
- drive the vehicle to any premises to be repaired or modified, to drive it during the process of repair or modification or to drive it to return it to its owner after repair or modification.

### A fleet owner (owns more than 50 vehicles)

The above eligible person or a person acting on their behalf may use the vehicle on a highway with a trade plate attached to the rear of the vehicle in the course of preparing it for registration, including in the course of testing or modifying the vehicle.

### A licensed vehicle tester

The above eligible person or a person acting on their behalf may use the vehicle on a highway with a trade plate attached to the rear of the vehicle, to:

- drive the vehicle from place to place to examine and test it; or
- drive the vehicle in the process of examining and testing it; or
- drive the vehicle in the course of collecting or returning it to its owner.

### A person or company recognised by VicRoads as providing a service of inspecting and checking vehicles for mechanical condition and efficiency

The above eligible person or a person acting on their behalf may use the vehicle on a highway with a trade plate attached to the rear of the vehicle, to:

- drive the vehicle from place to place to examine and test it; or
- drive the vehicle in the process of examining and testing it; or
- drive the vehicle in the course of collecting or returning it to its owner.

### Use of vehicle by a person engaged in the business of modifying, repairing, altering or transporting vehicles before registration

The above GIM/trade plate holder or a person acting on their behalf may use the vehicle on a highway with a trade plate attached to the rear of the vehicle, to:

- drive the vehicle to any premises to be altered, modified or repaired; or
- drive it during the process of alteration, modification or repair; or
- return it to its owner after alteration, modification or repair.
