

	With an increasingly aging population, antiresorptive medications like bisphosphonates and denosumab are prescribed daily for patients with osteoporosis or certain cancers. However, they come with a lesser-known risk: MRONJ. What's meant to preserve bone can, ironically, cause lasting damage to the jaw.
	MRONJ is a serious but largely preventable condition linked to commonly prescribed antiresorptive medications and antiangiogenic agents.
	This session will explore the link between these medications and jaw necrosis, highlighting the importance of pretherapy dental clearance and appropriate treatment strategies for confirmed MRONJ cases.
