

Chart Stimulated Recall (CSR) - Assessment for Learning

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

This workshop introduces healthcare professionals to Chart Stimulated Recall (CSR), a structured assessment method for exploring clinical reasoning. Through demonstration and practice, participants will learn CSR principles and how this approach reveals cognitive processes underlying clinical decision-making whilst facilitating meaningful educational dialogue.



**DURATION: 0.5 DAYS
(4 HOURS)**

The session builds faculty capacity to integrate CSR into teaching and assessment, emphasising its role in fostering deeper learner reflection. Participants will gain the knowledge and confidence to utilise CSR as a tool for developing thoughtful healthcare practitioners with sophisticated clinical reasoning skills.

PROGRAMME CONTENT

This programme comprises the following learning topics:

- How does Chart Stimulated Recall (CSR) work
- What can you do with CSR
- Does CSR work
- What makes CSR reliable



TARGET AUDIENCE

Clinical Educators/ Teachers, including APDs, CCFMs, Clinical Instructors, Subject Leads and Preceptors from all healthcare professions.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the end of the programme, participants will be able to:

- Explain the principles of Chart Stimulated Recall (CSR) and its role in assessing clinical reasoning among health professionals.
- Identify key steps in conducting CSR (chart selection, structured questioning, feedback).
- Recognize appropriate contexts and learner levels where CSR can be integrated into assessment.
- Practice framing CSR questions that elicit reasoning and reflection.
- Plan how to incorporate CSR into their own teaching and assessment practices.
