

Teaching in Clinical Settings

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

This workshop prepares clinicians to teach in a clinical setting. The basics of teaching and learning theories are presented with clear links to the clinical workplace to ensure immediate relevance and applicability.

Participants will discuss issues related to teaching in the presence of patients and will also engage in a simulated practicum where they will receive feedback from experienced clinical teachers in order to improve their teaching skills in both outpatient and inpatient settings.



DURATION: 0.5 DAY

- Adult learning theory
- Ethical principles in teaching
- Approaches to teaching clinical issues
- Facilitating a learning experience in a clinical setting
