Project Details

For two weekends in the summer of 2021, Ness Creek offered their festival experience on a much smaller scale. Each capsule weekend offered a packaged experience that included: accommodations (camping, canvas cottage or cabin)outdoor activities, arts and culture activities, culinary experiences (3 meals/day featuring local ingredients and suppers that included wine and beer pairings) a grand outdoor concert featuring Saskatchewan and Canada's best in original music.

Products Developed:

The market-ready package with a single point of purchase called Nesscape Mini Breaks was launched in July of 2021.
