Giving Feedings and Medications with a G-Tube

Preparing and Giving a G-Tube Feeding

- **1.** Hang feeding bag on IV pole so that it is above the level of the stomach and close the roller clamp.
- **2.** Pour feeding amount into feeding bag.
- **3.** Prime Tubing:
 - Slowly open the tubing roller clamp.
 - Allow formula to fill tubing and drip from the end.
 - Close the roller clamp.
 - Place the tubing into feeding pump.
- **4.** If using a Button G-Tube, attach an extension set.
- 5. Flush the G-Tube with 5 to 10 ml water.
- **6.** Connect the end of feeding bag tubing to G-Tube or Button extension set.
- 7. Open the roller clamp.
- **8.** Set the volume and rate on the feeding pump and start feeding.
- **9.** When done with feeding, flush the G-Tube with 5 to 10ml water to rinse.
- **10.** Close the roller clamp and remove feeding bag tubing from G-Tube or Button extension.
- **11.** Remove Button extension set.
- 12. Close G-Tube cap.

Cleaning the Feeding Bag, Tubing and Extension Set

- 1. Wash the G-Tube button extension set, feeding bag and tubing every day with warm soapy water made from 1-teaspoon dishwashing liquid soap and 1 quart of water.
- **2.** After washing, rinse well with water and hang to dry.

Giving Medication

- All medications given with a G-Tube must be in liquid form. ٠
- Always flush the G-Tube with 5ml water **before** and **after** all feedings and medications. •
- Give medications before giving feeding, if possible. ٠
- Use the side port on the MIC-G or Button G-Tube extension set to give medications. •
- If using a Foley G-Tube, use the same port to give medications and feedings. •
- Before giving a multivitamin, mix it in 3ml of formula. ٠
