BILLING

Any specimens sent to a lab or durable medical equipment such as braces or boots, are billed by their respective companies. 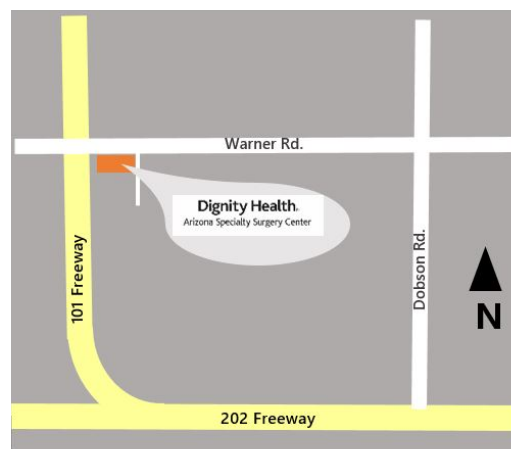

SURGERIES

- **DO...**
- Bring your **PHOTO ID**, insurance cards, deductibles, and co-pays.
- Wear loose fitting clothing.
- Take a shower or tub bath the morning of the surgery.
- Bring glasses, hearing aids, and a list of your current medications.
- Call your physician if you develop any symptoms of illness (for example temperature, sore throat, or rash) before coming to the Center for your surgery.
- Bring a toy or blanket if your child is having surgery. For infants bring a bottle or sippy cup for after the surgery.
- Bring guardianship papers, signed by the courts if you are not the parent of the minor. Minors must have a biological parent or legal guardian sign a permit before surgery can be performed.
- Please arrive at the Center one hour prior to your scheduled surgery time, unless otherwise instructed. We will use this time to prepare you for your surgery.
- Have the understanding that it is our policy to do pregnancy testing on all women who are currently in childbearing years.
- **DO NOT...**
- **Eat or drink anything** 8 hours prior to your procedure. This includes water, coffee, gum, lozenges, and medication (unless otherwise instructed by the pre-op nursing).
- **Wear jewelry or contact lenses** to the Center.
- **Bring any valuable items** to the Center; including wallet, credit cards, or money (unless it will be used to make a payment).
- **Wear lotion, perfume, powder, or aftershave** to the Center.
- **Shave or mark near surgical site prior to surgery.**

PAIN MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES

- **DO...**
- Bring your **PHOTO ID**, insurance cards, deductibles, and co-pays.
- Wear loose fitting clothing.
- Take a shower or tub bath the morning of the procedure.
- Bring glasses, hearing aids, and a list of your current medications.
- Call your physician if you develop any symptoms of illness or are on antibiotics (for example temperature, sore throat, or rash) before coming to the Center for your procedure.
- Please arrive at the Center 30 minutes prior your scheduled procedure time, unless otherwise instructed. We will use this time to prepare you for your procedure.
- Have the understanding that it is our policy to do pregnancy testing on all women who are currently in childbearing years.
- **DO NOT...**
- **Eat or drink anything** 8 hours prior to your procedure. This includes water, coffee, gum, lozenges, and medication (unless otherwise instructed by the pre-op nursing).
- **Wear jewelry or contact lenses** to the Center.
- **Bring any valuable items** to the Center; including wallet, credit cards, or money (unless it will be used to make a payment).

AFTER THE PROCEDURE/ AT HOME

A responsible adult will need to accompany you to provide transportation home after discharge from the center. To assure the patient's safety, taxi/uber rides are not allowed without a responsible adult to accompany the patient.

Make sure your ride is available and have someone with you at home the first day. Eat lightly the first 24 hours and be sure to follow your doctor's advice. Someone will call you the next business day to see how you are doing.

Be sure to call your doctor if you have uncontrolled pain, excessive persistent nausea or vomiting, fever or chills. If you are unable to reach your doctor, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.
