

Pre-procedure Instructions for Upper Endoscopy

Please bring a list of your current medications to your appointment. You must have a driver with you who will wait for you while you are under our care. If you do not have a driver, your appointment will be rescheduled.

- 1. Have a light dinner the night before your procedure. Avoid raw vegetables and salads.
- 2. Do **NOT** eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your procedure.
- 3. Patients on certain types of blood thinners MUST stop their medication several days before the exam. Please discuss this with your physician or nurse before your scheduled procedure.
- 4. Please inform your physician and the medical staff if you have a defibrillator or a pacemaker.
- 5. If you take medications for your heart and/or blood pressure, be sure to take them at your normally scheduled times. This includes on the morning of your procedure with a small sip of water. Hold all other medications until after your procedure.
- 6. If you take medication for diabetes, do not take it until after your procedure and you have eaten. This includes oral and injection medication.
