You must go online and complete your medical history with **One Medical Passport**. This is part of your pre-anesthetic evaluation and is required. This will take about 15-30 minutes, depending on your health history. We recommend that you complete your online history as soon as you receive the prompt to do so. You will not be able to complete it before you receive the prompt. Each visit to the facility requires you to revisit the site to update your information.

This does not apply to patients, having YAG procedures.

To begin your online Pre-surgical Assessment:

1. Go to our website: www.orlandosc.com.
2. On the Home Page, top left, choose "Online Clinical History"
3. When the new page loads, click on the large green "REGISTER" tab. There are language options on the upper right corner.
4. Sign in under "Welcome Back" for returning patients.

Be sure to have the following information available before starting your Medical Passport:

1. Your health insurance information.
2. The names, addresses and phone numbers of your physicians.
3. A list of all medications you are taking, their dosage and frequency.
4. A list of surgical procedures you have ever had and their approximate dates.

Completing a One Medical Passport medical history online is easy. For most patients, filling out the entire questionnaire takes less than 30 minutes. Please fill out the questionnaire accurately, and be assured that all of your information is kept confidential and will be thoroughly reviewed by your medical team. At any time, you can quit filling out the questionnaire and come back and complete the unfinished portion at a more convenient time. One Medical Passport is a website that allows you to enter your information at anytime from anywhere. You can also print out a copy of your medical history after you create it online and keep it with you or with your other health care documents, as well as, have access to it online anytime you need it or want to revise or update it.
