PREPPING FOR YOUR EGD/EUS

7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE

Medications:

Blood thinners -

- If you are taking Plavix, Coumadin (Warfarin), Lovenox, Xeralto, Eliquis, Brilinta or any
 other prescribed blood thinner, it's very important that you notify the nurse for instructions as
 when to STOP this medication before your procedure.
- **If you are taking 325mg Aspirin**, switch to 81mg Aspirin daily 7 days prior to your procedure and stay on this dose leading up to procedure.
- If you are already taking 81mg Aspirin, do not stop prior to procedure.

GLP – 1 injections

The following medication MUST be stopped 7 days prior to your procedure. If they are not stopped your procedure will be canceled and you will have to reschedule.

- GLP-1 injection medications (for diabetes and/or weight loss)
 - Ozempic(semaglutide) Wegovy(semaglutide) Trulicity(dulaglutide)
 Bydureon(exenatide) Mounjaro(trzepatide) Zepbound(trizepatide)
- Weight loss medications:
 - Adipex (phentermine)

The day prior to your procedure:

• No solid food after midnight, the night before your procedure

The day of your procedure:

• The morning of your procedure you may have clear liquids **ONLY**, up to <u>4 hours</u> prior to your procedure time.

Clear liquids include:

- water, tea, coffee (no milk/creamer), sodas, chicken or beef broth, apple juice, sports drinks, popsicles, and jello.
- NO red, purple, or milk products!

Medications day or procedure:

 Blood pressure, heart, seizure, and/or thyroid medications – please take 6 hours prior to your procedure with a sip of water.

NOTHING by mouth 4 hours before your procedure time, INCLUDING WATER!

IMPORTANT- Please note that females of childbearing age or 55 and under will be required to provide a urine sample for a pregnancy test at the time of check-in. If you are unable to provide a urine sample the procedure will be canceled.

→ You must have a someone drive you home from the procedure.

This must be a family member, friend, or approved medical transport service. No public transportation, uber, lyft, or any other ride share service.

→ There is a cancellation and no show policy

You will be charged a fee for cancellations within 72 hours of your scheduled procedure You will be charged a fee if you NO SHOW for your procedure.
