Objectives

- Explore trainees own personal life journey
- Identify and develop facilitation and communication skills.
- Enhance knowledge of grief and loss
- Develop an understanding of group dynamics
- Awareness of complex participants and appropriate referral process.
- Importance of self-care and ongoing education.
- Implement the BlueCare Grief and Loss Program at BlueCare facilities and in the wider community.

Course Structure

Prior to the commencement of the course there is an application form to complete, a phone interview, and a requirement for a written exercise, which forms the application to proceed.

The course includes Grief & Loss of a Loved One (2½ days) and Grief, Loss & Dementia (1½ days).

The two courses can be run all together over 4 days or at different times. A certification of completion will be attained after satisfactory facilitation of a Grief and Loss program with an established facilitator.

The course involves experiential and practical learning.
