

WASTE SORTING NATURALLY!

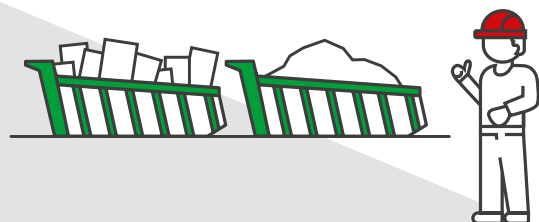
Are you working on one of our projects? Then you sort waste at the construction site. Why? Because the waste you sort can again be used as raw material for new products. This makes a big difference to the environment.

Put it in the right bin

We sort waste in as many containers as possible. You can find them in the waste disposal area on the construction site, the place where we sort our waste. The containers most commonly found on construction sites are:

- rubble
- wood
- gypsum
- hard plastics
- foil
- paper/cardboard

There are explanations for each waste stream on the back.

Before you get to work, check which waste containers are on the construction site.



Check the waste signs on the containers for what to dispose of.

- ✓ Street tiles

- ✓ Sand-lime brick (max 5%)
- ✓ Masonry waste
- ✓ Tiles

- ✗ Aerated concrete
- ✗ Insulation material
- ✗ Tarry asphalt debris
- ✗ Uncured cement or concrete



WOOD B

- ✓ Treated wood
- ✓ Painted wood
- ✓ Fibreboard / Particleboard
- ✓ MDF / Plywood
- ✓ OSB board

- ✗ Impregnated wood
- ✗ Wolmanised wood
- ✗ Tree trunks



GYPSON

- ✓ Gypsum blocks
- ✓ Plasterboards

- ✗ Rubble
- ✗ Glue bags
- ✗ Construction foam (PUR)



MIXED HARD PLASTICS

- ✓ PVC
- ✓ Buckets
- ✓ Crates
- ✓ Tubes
- ✓ Straps (packaging straps)

- ✗ Foil
- ✗ Aluminium
- ✗ Contaminated plastics



FOIL

- ✓ LDPE film
- ✓ Packaging film
- ✓ Stretch film
- ✓ Shrink film
- ✓ Wrapping film
- ✓ Vapour barrier film
- ✓ Plastic sheeting

- ✗ Straps (packaging straps)
- ✗ Agricultural film
- ✗ Hard plastics
- ✗ Contaminated film
- ✗ PVC



PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ (Printer) paper
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Newspaper

- ✗ Contaminated paper
- ✗ Cardboard drinks container
- ✗ Protection cardboard
- ✗ Cellophane, carbon and masking paper
- ✗ Wallpaper



CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

✓ Please!

Only put items in this container that **cannot** be separated in other containers

- ✗ Hazardous waste
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Roof waste
- ✗ Wood
- ✗ Used silicone cartridges
- ✗ Commercial waste
- ✗ Electronic equipment
