## Annual General Meeting 2024

Zurich Insurance Group Ltd (ZIG) also published today the invitation to the [Annual General Meeting](#) (AGM) 2024, which takes place on April 10, 2024 at the Hallenstadion in Zurich, Switzerland.

As announced on February 22, 2024, the Board of Directors will propose to elect John Rafter as a new member. Dame Alison Carnwath will not stand for re-election, as she reached the maximum tenure of 12 years. The Chairman and all the other current members of [ZIG's Board of Directors](#) and Remuneration Committee will stand for re-election.
