Tailored coverage enhancements

Our specialized policy form provides several additional coverage extensions to help meet the needs of the unique exposures of a mass timber construction project, including:

Pre-Assembly Sites

- Adds coverage for locations where additional post-manufacturing, pre-assembly work must be done, with a separate limit from other temporary offsite locations
- Offers the ability to specifically schedule locations requiring higher limits on the Declarations without need for an endorsement

Temporary Monitoring Equipment

 Adds coverage for fire, water or security-monitoring equipment located at the project site

Temporary Offsite Locations

- Able to be scheduled on the Declarations when higher site-specific offsite storage limits are required, clarifying the lower policy level limit from scheduled locations
- Definition updated to dovetail with the new Pre-Assembly Sites coverage
