## Focus: Leading cause of employee injury within the Aegis captive

Slips, and Falls, remain as the leading cause of employee injury within the Aegis captive, with ankle sprains while entering and exiting vehicles as the most frequent type of loss. Since 10/1/2025, the captive has experienced four slip and fall claims exceeding \$100,000 incurred costs. To better understand these incidents and help prevent similar injuries, Zurich Resilience Solutions interviewed each DSP involved to identify key lessons learned and practical prevention strategies.

May's Large Loss contains a summary document that highlights the **Key Lessons Learned** from recent large loss incidents. This document is intended to be shared with all employees and managers and is aimed at supporting efforts to help prevent future injuries.
