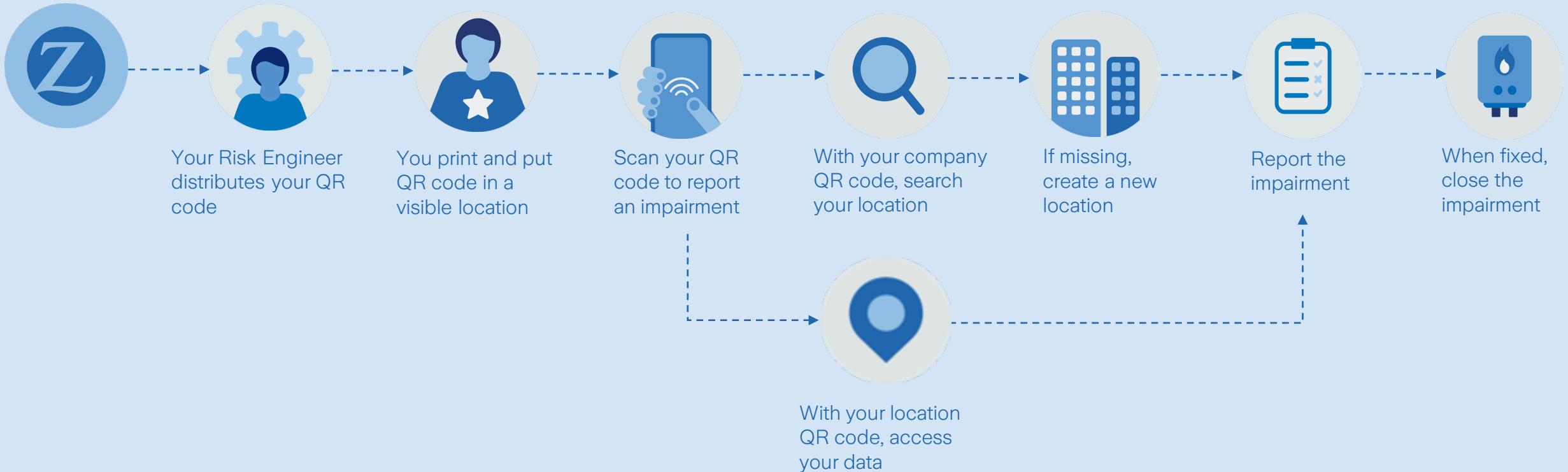


# Impairment Notification System

## Legal Note

1. Your risk engineer provides you with a company or location QR code.
2. When there is an impairment, scan your QR code. In the website that will be opened, enter your e-mail address. You will receive a verification code in your mailbox. A new verification code is needed every time you create, modify, or close an impairment notification.
3. Search the location of the impairment or create the location if you can't find it.
4. Introduce your impairment data, including the verification code. Once created, you will receive a report with the impairment data and a QR code of your impairment.
5. Print your impairment notification report and put it in a highly visible place in your impaired system.
6. Scan your impairment-specific QR code to get access to your data and report any update on the progress and close the impairment notification when the system is connected again.
7. The Impairment Notification System will send you reminders if the notification is still open after the estimated date of restoration.
