Mitigation

- Commissioning and Recommissioning plans for new and existing piping networks for construction / renovation projects.
- Mechanical, Plumbing, Fire Protection, and other process piping valve location identification and charting.
- 3 Water, temperature, and other liquid sensors.
- 4 Wet work permits.
- 5 W-Rated firestopping products in floor ceiling assemblies.
- 6 Specific mitigation measures for critical equipment areas.

Preparedness

- Preventive maintenance standards for fire protection and other mechanical, plumbing, and process piping networks, including valves.
- 8 A regularly scheduled building envelop assessment, including roof system and drainage, cladding, and glazing.
- 9 A regularly scheduled grounds assessment of storm drains.
- 10 Water and liquid spill response cart(s) to handle small spill incidents.
- 11 Staff training on responding to water and liquid damage.
- 12 Vendor training on liquid damage prevention.

- 13 A "First 24-hour response plan.
- 14 Signed contract with large loss mitigation vendor(s).
- 15 Signed contract with professional equipment restoration vendors.
